### **\*\*\* New Bitty Ball Camp \*\*\***

Bitty Ball camp is for 4-year-old players instead of T-ball. Players will meet in a practice setting for several weeks.

The disparity between 4 and 6 year old player's size and skill level in addition to the prospect of playing 3 years of T-ball has necessitated a new structure, thus the Bitty Ball camp.

### **For Boys and Girls ages 5-16**

#### **T-Ball ages 5-6**

\$65 per player (\$25 fee + \$40 Reimbursable Fundraiser option) not to exceed \$90 per family

#### **All other groups**

\$70 per person (\$30 fee + \$40 Reimbursable Fundraiser option) not to exceed \$100 per family

#### **Combination of T-ball and other age group**

\$95 for a combination of T-Ball and other children in family  
(\$25 + 30 + \$40 Reimbursable Fundraiser option)

#### **Competitive Option ages 9-16**

\$110 per player for all ages (\$30 fee + \$40 fundraiser + \$40 competitive fee)

2 Competitive players in family, pay all competitive fees

(\$100 family fee + 2 competitive fees @ \$40 each = \$180)

2<sup>nd</sup> set of raffle tickets are available to total \$80 optional fundraiser available to family

If registration is not received **before March 6th** a \$20 late fee will be charged.

#### **PYBSA Fundraiser option 2010:**

**Raffle tickets** – To receive a \$40 fundraiser discount, players must sell 40 raffle tickets & return stubs to the league for the drawing. Parents pay for tickets at time of registration and reimburse themselves as they sell tickets.

If you mail in an application, your coach will deliver your raffle tickets.

## **Competitive Option Ages 9-16 Only**

This is for the player / parent who is interested in more than a 12 game recreational schedule and who desire a more competitive, serious environment than a recreational team offers. PYBSA offers the option of an additional competitive schedule that will play at least two competitive tournaments, other competitive games and a recreational schedule. Each age group will have one competitive team limited to 12 players. Objective tryouts will be held if necessary. Travel will be limited to semi-local tournaments: Jacksonville, Virden, Auburn etc. You can obtain more information at the on-site registration dates listed above.

PYBSA has always offered recreational baseball & softball in the past. In order to try to keep kids playing in Pawnee and for Pawnee teams, the board has decided to create a competitive team option. Competitive baseball/softball and recreational baseball/softball have distinct differences.

Competitive teams play high-level competitive games. We are offering the chance for children to play a recreational schedule as an “A” team and play additional games against competitive teams and finally, to play in several competitive tournaments (10-12 games) for an additional \$40. Equal playing time is not guaranteed on competitive teams. Competitive teams focus on advanced fundamentals and concepts and play to win. The roster size for these teams is limited to 12 players. If more than 12 players choose to participate, closed tryouts will be held and team members will be selected objectively by the team coaches. Copies of birth certificates must be supplied to be on the roster of a competitive team. Children who do not make the 1<sup>st</sup> team will be listed as 1<sup>st</sup> alternate, 2<sup>nd</sup> alternate etc. so these children may have a chance to play if original team members are unavailable.

Recreational teams will still be formed and play a regular league schedule against other small towns in the area. Recreational teams usually play in a rec. tournament or two a year (ex. Morrisonville tournament, Virden tournament etc.) A goal for recreational teams is to provide fairly equal playing time for all players. The emphasis on recreational teams is fundamentals and fun.

Pawnee children will now have the ability to play for their regular recreational team and a competitive team, if they choose, without having to play for another town, play all games out of town or pay an exorbitant fee to play competitive baseball/softball.

We hope the parents and children welcome this addition to our program.
