Tournament Rules

We will use MLB rules with the following exceptions:

Pitching Limitations

- 7 innings in one day
- 14 innings for the tournament
- One pitch constitutes an inning
- Please use good judgment with your pitchers

Players must slide at home if there is a play at home. Players can't run over the catcher or anybody else covering home. Players will be ejected for that game and called out.

Time limit is 1 hour and 45 minutes. No new inning can begin after the time limit unless the game is tied.

The next inning starts when the 3rd out is made in the previous inning.

We will start the games early if we get the chance.

There will be no ties.

Length of games will be 7 innings. Game will be considered official following completion of the third inning. There will be a 15 run rule after 3 innings, 12 run rule after 4 innings and 10 run rule after 5 innings.

Courtesy runner can be used for the catcher at anytime. Courtesy runner should be player not in the game. If no such player is available use the player that made the last out.

You can use an EH if you want.

Home team will keep official book.

Home team will be determined by coin flip.

Home team turns in pitching records and the score to tournament rep.



The teams will be seeded after the first 2 games are played by all teams.

Individual awards will be given to the top 3 teams.

Refunds in the event of rain

0 games played – 100%

1 game played – 50%

2 games played – 0% - tournament will be considered official if all teams complete 2 games.

Please have your Birth Certificates with you. I am not going to check Birth Certificates, but have them with you in case somebody questions one of your players.

Directions from I-55: Take RT. 104 to Pawnee to 4th street turn left on 4th street. From Taylorville turn right on 4th street. School Diamonds will be on your right. North Park will be at the end of 4th street. You take a left at the stop sign.

Do not park on the street at North Park. You can park at the City Maintenance building if the parking lot is full. If we do this we will all be friends with the Village Police.

We will have a full concession stand.
